## These organizations ensure a safe port:



### HARBOUR MASTER'S DIVISION

- Ensuring safe and smooth shipping
- Planning and admission of ships
- Inspection and enforcement in relation to environment and safety
- Patrolling on the water
- Monitoring the application of international rules for the security of companies and ships as Port Security Officer

### COAST GUARD

- Monitoring maritime shipping
- Rescue operations at sea
- Inspecting ships for compliance with maritime laws and regulations

### CUSTOMS

- Enforcing laws and regulations for the import and export of freight

### SEAPORT POLICE

- Initial response to incidents
- Ensuring compliance with navigation rules
- Enforcement of environmental regulations for ships in the port
- Fighting crime

### LABOUR INSPECTORATE

- Monitoring compliance with labour laws and regulations
- Detecting fraud and labour exploitation

### ILT Human Environment and Transport Inspectorate

- Monitoring the safety of ships, cargo, and working conditions
- Monitoring the transport of hazardous substances and waste

### HARC-TEAM

- Investigation into drug smuggling and criminal networks
- Specialists from Customs, Seaport Police, Netherlands Fiscal Information & Investigation Service (FIOD), and Public Prosecutor

### FERM

- Combating cybercrime
- Increasing digital resilience in the port

### RIJNMOND DCMR ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

- Granting permits and inspecting companies in relation to environment and safety
- Monitoring environmental quality in the region
- Handling complaints from residents

### NVWA Netherlands Food & Consumer Product Safety Authority

- Monitoring imports and exports in the areas of food safety, animal welfare, plants, and product safety
